Do you have Primary Biliary Cholangitis (formerly known as Primary Biliary Cirrhosis) (PBC)?

We are looking for native speakers of English, men and women, over 18, who have experienced itching caused by primary biliary cholangitis (PBC), to help us evaluate the English translations of a group of questionnaires about their personal experience with PBC. These questionnaires will be used during an upcoming clinical trial of a new drug for PBC.

You will be compensated \$150 for participating in a 1.5 to 2-hour interview. At the beginning of the interview you will be asked to take several questionnaires that have been translated into English and then the interviewer will ask you a series of questions about how easy it was for you to understand the translation. There are no right or wrong answers. We only want to know if the questions are understandable and applicable for you.

The information you provide during the interview will be kept confidential. We will not have access to your medical records and we will not make any recording of the interview.

The study investigator will travel to your city to do these interviews, so you would need to be available during a certain timeframe in order to participate. These dates have not yet been scheduled.
